Discussion of this year's CCS Championships match: The match will be at ARPC. Match fee is \$65 and \$30 for juniors before June 1st. After June 1st the fee is \$85, juniors remains \$30. Division winners will be given plaques class winners will receive medals. 120 maximum entries. We will use squad leaders rather than fixed RO's. Squad leaders will shoot for a reduced fee of \$45. There will be four guns given away by random drawing. Three to competitors and one to staff. Squad leaders will be in both drawings.

Discussion of Steel Challenge Shooting Association rules: Chuck informed the board there is a committee looking into the rules in an attempt to codify them.

Mark asked the board if putting the news letter on the website would meet their approval. Unanimously agreed upon. The newsletter will now be published on the website each month and a notice will be sent out to the email list when it is available.
